Registration for classes is done on a first- come-first-served basis. You may register by mail or in person. Phone registration will not be accepted for classes. Forms will be processed in the order received. Please indicate a first and second choice. **You will be notified only if you do not receive your first choice.** When a class fills, we create a waiting list. If there is enough interest, we may create a second section.

By Mail: You may mail in this form right away, completely filled out and with exact payment by check or credit card. (Do not mail cash.)

In Person: You may register in person right away. Office hours are 10am to 5pm on Tuesday through Friday.

Fees: Payment by check, cash, or credit card is due with registration. Registration fees cover firing and the first 25# of clay. Additional clay may be purchased for \$14/bag for most shop clays.

Cancellation Policy: If cancellation is less than two weeks before the first class, \$50 will be withheld from refunds. After the first class, no fees are refundable. We reserve the right to cancel classes if the minimum enrollment is not reached; full tuition will be returned. Fees paid for the current session may not be transferred to a future session.

Student Responsibilities: Class members are expected to participate in the recycling of clay, in the loading, unloading, and firing of class kilns under the guidance of instructors, and to participate in the maintenance and cleanup of the studio. Further, student use of our facilities to produce goods for commercial sale is not acceptable. Pottery making can be a potentially hazardous activity. It is the responsibility of every student to exercise caution at all times within the pottery.
